Buffalo Bill State Historical Park

North Platte was home of the man who made the Wild West world-renowned. No one figure personifies the frontier spirit better than William F. "Buffalo Bill" Cody, the West's most colorful showman, army scout and buffalo hunter.

His legacy lives on at Buffalo Bill Ranch State Historical Park. Cody's elegant Victorian house, built in 1886, and huge barn sits on 258 acres of what was originally a 4,000-acre spread that Cody called Scout's Rest Ranch.

The barn, built in 1887, now features Wild West Show memorabilia, original posters, and a movie made of film clips taken at the time the show was touring throughout the United States and Europe.

The house, barn, and original outbuildings are now being preserved by the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission as a state historical park.

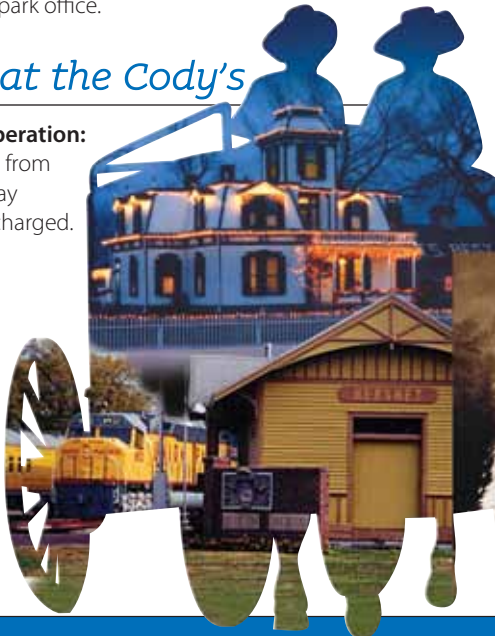

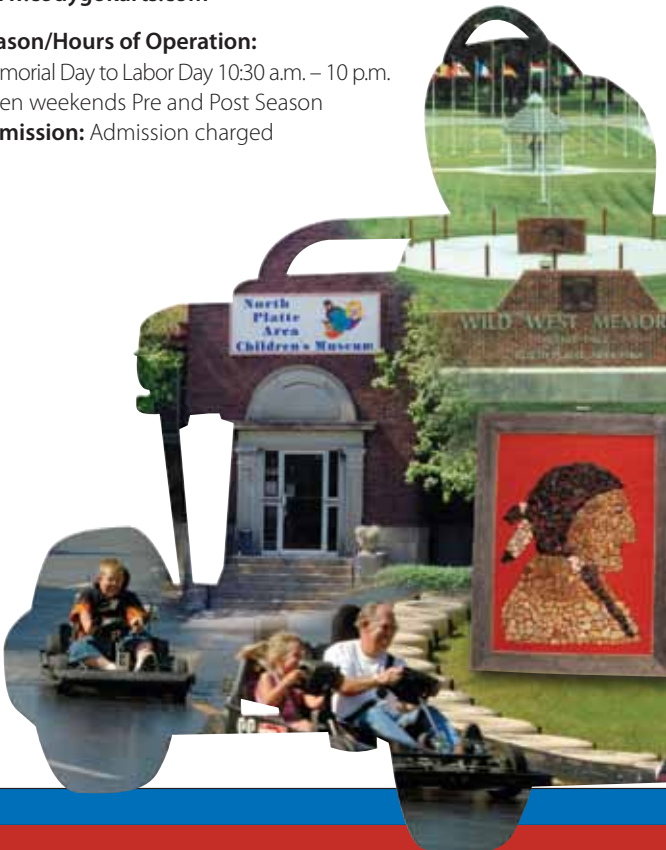

Wild West Memorial

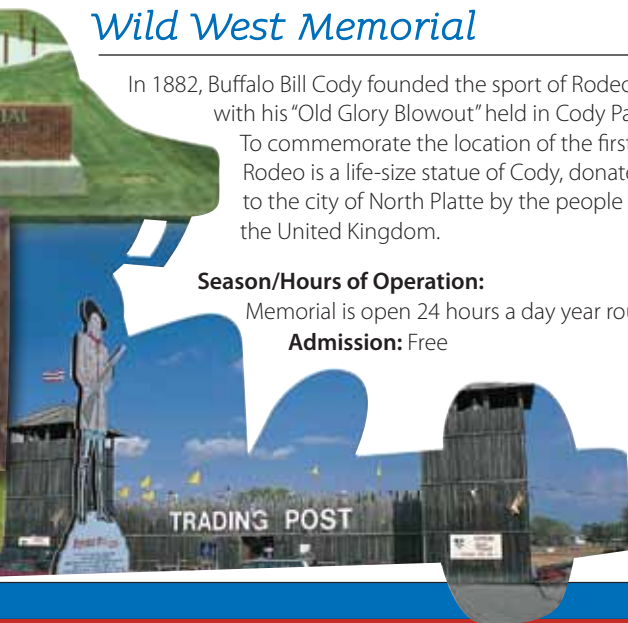
In 1882, Buffalo Bill Cody founded the sport of Rodeo with his "Old Glory Blowout" held in Cody Park.

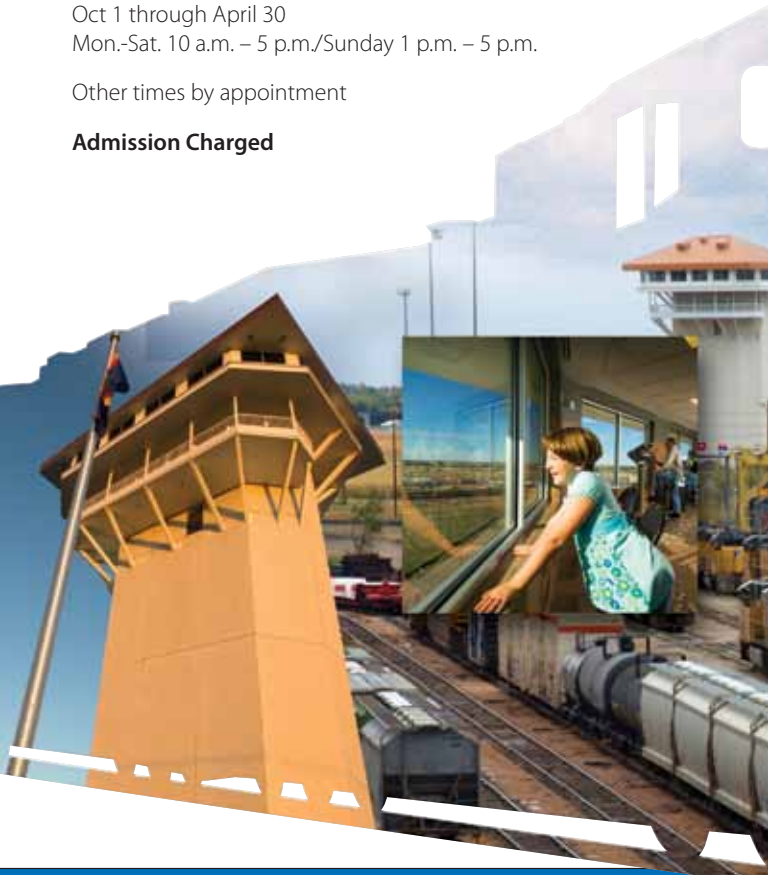
